## SKELETAL POCKET WATCH

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- The pocket watch should be wound every 36-40 hours, but care should be taken not to overwind.
- To adjust the time, pull the crown wheel gently out until it clicks, then rotate until the correct time shows. Push the crown wheel in to restart the watch.
- **(Fig.i)** To open case, hold the watch flat in the palm of the hand, face upwards, and press the button in the centre of the crown. The lid will then pop open.
- **(Fig.ii)** To open the second lid press the button in the centre of the crown slightly further: the rear lid will then pop open to fully reveal the mechanical movement.

When closing the lids, please ensure that the crown button is pressed in order to prevent wear on the closure catches.

The Skeletal Pocket Watch is precision deep-engraved with the Latin inscription: TEMPUS NEMINEM MANET: Time waits for no man.

- The scratch resistant glass lens and windows ensure that the face is clearly read.
- The sprung lids protect the watch, and pop open at the press of a button.
- Supplied with a quality pocket watch chain and pocket watch stand.
- Comes with the Dalvey quality guarantee.

**Please note:** The lids of this pocket watch do not open beyond 80° due to the design of the discreet hinge mechanism. If the lids are forced open beyond 80° it will damage the watch and invalidate the warranty.
